EDSFAT Charging Policy 1st April 2009 – 31st March 2010

Charges valid for Scouting events (+ other voluntary organisations) in East and West Sussex. For events outside these two counties and for all events with over 500 participants (including event staff) please contact EDSFAT to discuss.

1 - The vehicles are taken to an event to act as mobile (or static) treatment areas. A number of events may not require a vehicle as a suitable treatment area may already be available or may be provided by the organiser. EDSFAT will discuss with the Event Organiser any vehicle requirements. Some events may require more than one vehicle.

The First Aid Communication vehicle will be provided by EDSFAT for its own First Aid radio control at events where they deem it appropriate and therefore will not charge for its use.

2 – Includes Friday evening to Sunday afternoon. Please contact us to discuss charges for camps longer than a two day weekend.

3 - As EDSFAT encourages learning and training of its members they may provide more equipment or personnel than required and will therefore do so at no extra cost to the event organiser.

4 – Any additional expenses (e.g. Hall hire) incurred by EDSFAT where required facilities are not provided by the event organiser will be charged at cost.
